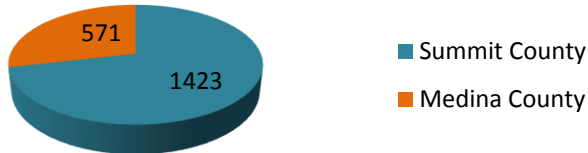

Individuals Served (Summit County 6096, Medina County 463)

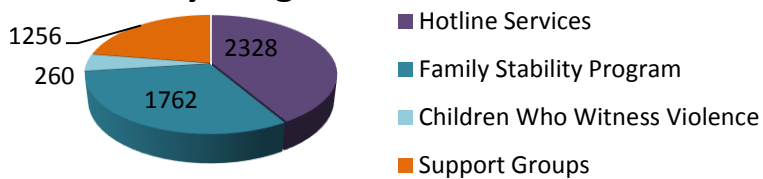
Shelter: Nights Provided



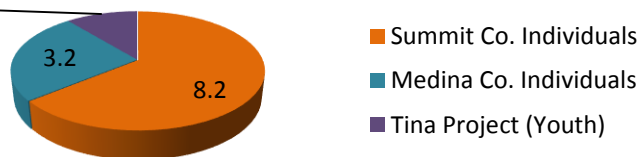
Court Services: Clients Served



Community Programs



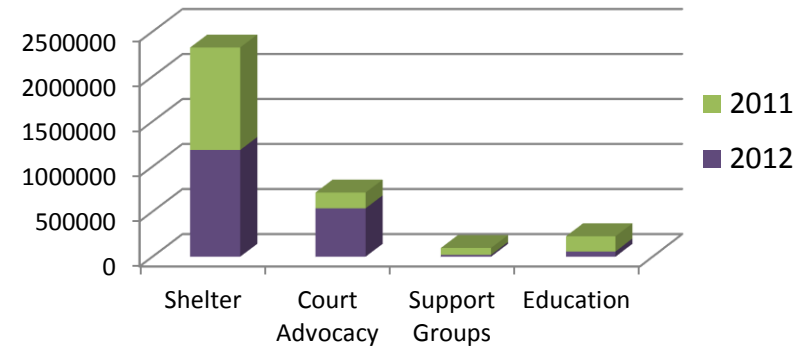
