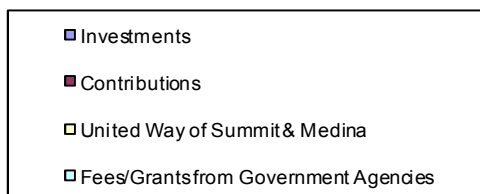
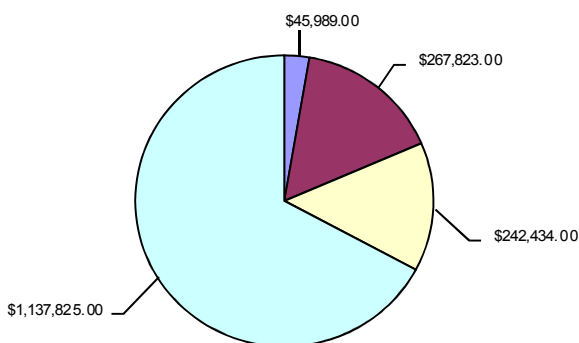
*The mission of the Battered Women's Shelter is:*

4. *To break the cycle of abuse through comprehensive, quality crisis intervention services to all families living in a domestic violence life*

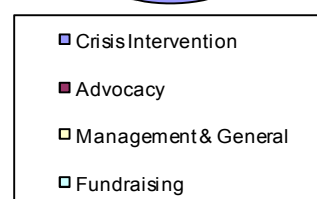
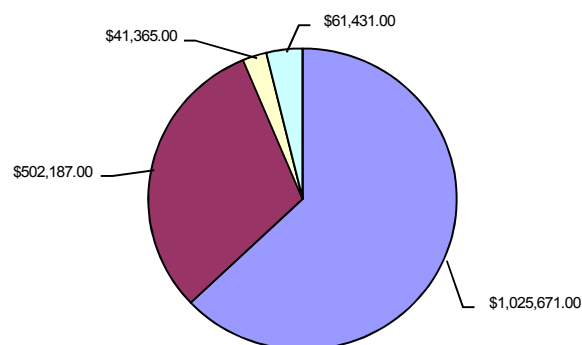
**FISCAL YEAR 2006 BATTERED WOMEN'S SHELTER REVENUE & EXPENSES**
